COMMUNITY: Port Jervis High School serves a community of 16,000 people over an area of 125 square miles which includes the City of Port Jervis and the Town of Deerpark in Orange County. Located in a tri-state area, our secondary schools also include tuition students from Montague, NJ. The community has an average socioeconomic status with a large senior citizen population. The metropolitan area of New York City provides many cultural and educational opportunities as well as areas of employment for our residents.

SCHOOL: Port Jervis High School is located on Rt. 209, Port Jervis, NY. It is a modern structure, attached by Anna S. Kuhl Elementary School. Enrollment in grades 9 through 12 is **964**.

RANK IN CLASS AND GPA: Grade point average and class rank reflect the academic achievement of all students during their enrollment at Port Jervis High and are computer-generated at the conclusion of each year. All courses are included in the computation with the exception of those graded on a pass/fail basis. Honors, AP, College and Regents courses are weighted an additional 7 points for ranking.

CURRICULA: Comprehensive High School program with sequential courses available in all college preparatory subjects as well as in art, music, family and consumer science, business and technology. Twenty-two credits including physical education, computer literacy and the successful completion of competency tests are required for graduation. New York State Regents, Advanced Regents, or local school diplomas are available.

Port Jervis High School requires a minimum of 22 credits and passing grades on NY State Competency exams for graduation.

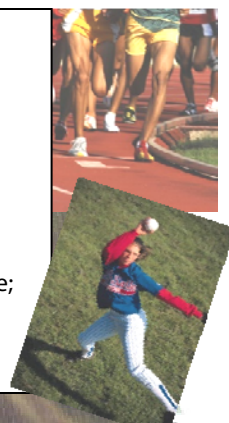
